WHEREAS, Shauna Mora has served as Executive Director of the Conflict Resolution Center of Santa Cruz County (CRC) since 2012; and

WHEREAS, founded in 1986, the CRC's mission is to help create more peaceful communities through respectful dialogue, and provides more effective alternatives to litigation, hostility and violence by facilitating conversations in which participants practice deep listening, increase their understanding of each other, and create their own mutually beneficial solutions; and

WHEREAS, Shauna, as Executive Director, implemented a new strategic direction for CRC, leading to years of sustainability for the organization; and

WHEREAS, Shauna widely increased the visibility of CRC across the Santa Cruz community, leading to greater respect and support for the organization; and

WHEREAS, Shauna was instrumental in CRC being awarded a four year Community Leadership Project grant, enabling successful results based on the grant's requirements; and

WHEREAS, during her time with the CRC, Shauna worked hard to build strong relationships with other Santa Cruz non-profit organizations such as the Human Care Alliance and the Youth Violence Prevention Task Force, and was a great partner with the County Probation Department by providing conflict management support and training to enable more effective teams.
