I'm strongly in support of this proposal since PG&E told us that trees have never damaged transmission lines nor have they ever impeded access to transmission lines during an emergency in any significant way. PG&E told us that trees played no part in the San Bruno disaster. And PG&E told us that all transmission lines in Santa Cruz County have been tested recently and are in good working order.

Under the guise of "proactive" public safety, PG&E is systematically undermining the life support systems that we all depend on.

In the face of our current environmental crises, PG&E's deceitful and self-serving actions are criminal! Santa Cruz will have to bear the long-lasting consequences of these actions in the form of home and property devaluation, soil, air, and water pollution, and loss of wildlife, beauty, peace, and spiritual communion.

Please include private properties in your framework agreement, just as they are doing in Palo Alto. It is important that these trees be protected, too.

Please coordinate with other communities across PG&E's service area as well as with the State so that we have a chance to stop PG&E's destructive actions altogether.

Finally, we need to strengthen our environmental protection ordinances. I recommend Santa Cruz adopt a Bill of Rights for Nature. Our County's lands and waters have been pillaged for over 200 years. It's time to stop the madness.
