

**Notice of Public Hearing
Before the Board of Supervisors
of the County of Santa Cruz**

Notice is hereby given that the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors has scheduled a public hearing for November 17, 2020 at 9:00am or thereafter in the Board Chambers, 701 Ocean Street, Room 525, Santa Cruz, California, to consider the recommendation of the Planning Commission to approve application 181609, a proposal to add Parcel 064-272-01 (4700 Highway 9) to the Permanent Room Housing (PRH) Combining Zone District, and recognize six PRH units on this property. Requires a rezoning, commercial development permit, and determination that the project is exempt from further environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Property is located on the east side of Highway 9, at the intersection with Old Big Trees Rd.

Note: The public may attend the public hearing and/or comment on this matter. Testimony may be presented in person or submitted in written form prior to the hearing and made a part of the hearing record.

If any person challenges an action taken on the foregoing matters in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at or prior to the public hearing.
