Dear Board of Supervisors,

The tragedy of the CZU fire has placed a tremendous focus in our community to do everything possible to maintain the safety of our families, friends and neighbors.

The Lompico area has approximately 2,000 in addition to 100's of potential Loch Lomond guests sharing a single exit using Lompico Road.

The community of Lompico is asking for assistance from the County Board of Supervisors in 2 areas:

#1

The identification and planning for 2 additional emergency evacuation routes out of the Lompico area. Potential routes are a private road(s) off of West to Newell Creek and a private road(s) off of Lake to the intersection of Lompico and Zayante.

#2

A request from the county to the City of Santa Cruz for a wildfire evacuation plan for the guests of Loch Lomond which is to be shared with the public.

We realize the CZU tragedy has stretched the county resources thin. There are many members of the community willing to assist in any way to make our neighborhood safer.

Thank you to all of the folks in the emergency services and county services who are bravely leading us through this tragedy. It makes us proud to be a part of the Santa Cruz Mountains.
